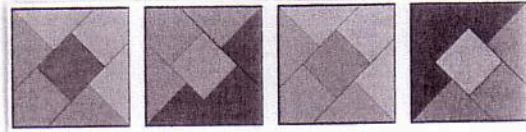


Block of the Month for October Mud In The Hole



Instructions are for two blocks

Cut from two different red fabrics a 3 1/2" square for A

Cut one 6" square from each of a light grey and dark grey, and cut in half diagonally for B

Cut one 6 3/8" square from the same light grey and dark grey, and cut in half diagonally twice for C

Fold each A square in half wrong sides together: press a fold mark in the center of each of the opposite edges. Fold each B triangle in half along the long edge, right sides together; press 1" along the fold.

Sew the B triangles to the opposite sides of the A square, matching center marks.

Line up the right edge of your ruler with the right edge of the A square. The 1 3/4" line of the ruler aligns with the top and bottom triangle points.

Cut along the right edge to trim away the excess triangle edges. Repeat with the opposite edge.

Sew the C Triangles together in pairs as shown using one triangle of each colour for each pair. Be sure the pairs are oriented correctly before sewing.

Sew the triangle units to opposite sides of the A/B units as shown.
